## HAD COUNTRY LIQUOR, ALLEGE KIN; NO METHANOL FOUND IN BLOOD, SAY COPS

# 3 die after consuming 'jal jeera' in Kheda; cardiac arrest primary cause, says report

Three people have died after allegedly consuming a drink, suspected to be poisonous, in Kheda district's Nadiad town, said police on Monday, adding a probe has been launched into the matter. The incident took place Sunday night in Jawaharnagar area of the town.

On Monday evening, the primary cause of death — reported after the panel postmortem examination — of the three men was stated to be "cardiac arrest", even as the Kheda Superintendent of Police Rajesh Gadhiya handed over the investigation to the Local Crime Branch.

Police said that a case of unnatural death has been lodged at the Nadiad town police station as the investigators await the detailed forensic report to establish the nature of the toxic chemical that could have led to the deaths.

While the families of the three victims have claimed that the men consumed country liquor, the police have said that

the forensic test of the blood sample of the deceased did not reveal the presence of methanol.

According to the police, the three men allegedly collapsed within minutes of consuming the drink. The police said that the victims Yogesh Kushwah (40), Ravindra Rathod (59) and Kanu Chauhan (54), are alleged to have consumed a locally sold "jeera soda" from a shop after which they allegedly collapsed and were rushed to the civil hospital, where they were declared dead.

SP Gadhiya told *The Indian Express*, "According to the main eye-witness in the case, who also rushed the three men to the hospital when they collapsed, Chauhan had brought the drink

and shared it with Rathod and Kushwah. The three were acquaintances and met regularly at the spot."

"The same drink has been consumed by many other people on the same day but no other case has been reported. Therefore, the FSL team has collected the bottle that the three men drank from, along with a few others, from the dustbin near the shop where the bottle had been discarded," said the SP.

Gadhiya added that the three men allegedly offered the drink to other people, including the eye-witness, but no one else consumed it from their bottle.

Gadhiya said, "It is bottled jeera soda that is sold in local stores. The primary FSL report has not indicated the presence of methanol, so it was not country liquor. But, we are investigating the possibility that the bottle that was brought by Kanu Chauhan could have been laced with poison... a similar case happened in Junagadh a few years ago. We are trying to ascertain if Chauhan purchased the bottle himself or it was given to him by

someone, who intended to harm him."

Gadhiya added that the exact cause of death will be known after they receive the detailed histopathology report of the deceased. "Samples of their viscera have also been sent to the FSL Gandhinagar for a detailed report... the process is on to ascertain facts," said Gadhiya.

Meanwhile, the families of the deceased claimed that the men were "habitual drinkers" and indulged in consuming country liquor almost daily.

Victim Kanu Chauhan's uncle, PK Chauhan, said, "My nephew was hearing and speech impaired and used to earn a few rupees by setting up a weighing scale near the Jawaharnagar railway crossing. Whatever little money he made every evening, he would spend on country liquor. He had been drinking it for almost five years." "Last night we received a call that he had collapsed. Within half an hour the three men died and I called the police," Chauhan added.

Another victim, Kushwah's son, Sunny, said, "My father used to sell fritters on his cart. He oc-

asionally consumed country liquor. Last evening, too, he may have gone to consume the same brew. We do not know what he had... I received a call that he had met with an accident but when I reached the civil hospital, he was declared dead."

SP Gadhiya said: "We are ascertaining what was in the drink. If it would have been country liquor, the presence of methanol in the blood sample would have confirmed it."

In November 2023, five people had died in three villages of Bilodra, Vadadla and Bagdu village in the district after allegedly consuming "spurious Ayurvedic syrup" Kal Meghasava, between November 26 and 28, 2023.

A Special Investigation Team (SIT) formed to investigate the case had arrested six people in the case after it had been established that the spurious ayurvedic syrup was manufactured in a unit in Nadiad by mixing sanitiser and misusing the Food and Drug Control Administration (FDCA) license issued to one of the accused for ayurvedic manufacturing under Yogi Ayurveda.

## 'Won't let a single home stand here': Ahead of ward election in Vadodara, BJP leader's 'warning' to voters

BJP DISTRICT President Satish Patel, during an election campaign in a minority dominated neighbourhood in Vadodara, has allegedly said, in a purported video that has gone viral, that if the party's panel of four contestants fails to win in the area, "homes will be demolished".

The remarks were made when Patel, accompanied by BJP Vadodara City Unit President Vijay Shah, who is in-charge of the Karjan municipality polls, was campaigning in Ward 7 on Sunday.

Here, the party faces its one-time stalwart, Mohammad Yusuf Sindhi, as a rebel candidate from the AAP. The BJP has also included a Muslim candidate — Mumtaz Hussain Multani — in its panel of four. The BJP is up for a challenging

contest in the February 16 local body polls in the Karjan Municipality after 16 of its rebel leaders filed nominations from the AAP. In his address, while warning the voters to "not go astray", Patel could purportedly be heard announcing from the stage, "If you ensure the victory of the BJP's panel of four, I assure you that no homes will be demolished. But if you betray us and the BJP does not

win, I also guarantee you that I won't let even a single home stand here..." In his speech, Patel can also be heard purportedly alleging that Sindhi, who has been suspended from the BJP for rebelling and filing nominations from the AAP for the upcoming polls, had been "extorting" money from several residents in the area.

In the video, Shah could purportedly be seen seconding Patel and urging residents to vote for changing the "Mohammadnagri" to "Ram Nagri" by driving out the "Ravan".

The leaders could not be contacted for comment on the purported video. While BJP has fielded Jyoti Vasava, Tarun Parmar and Pranavrajsinh Atalia along with Multani from Ward 7, AAP candidates in the contest include, besides Sindhi, Priyanka Machhi, Bharat Atalia and Vinita Vasava.

## On way back from Vadodara with two kids, couple killed as SUV rams truck

Ahmedabad: A couple travelling from Vadodara to Ahmedabad, along with their children, was killed after their SUV ramed the backside of a truck on National Expressway-1 (NE-1) during the wee hours of Monday, police said.

While their 12-year-old daughter escaped unhurt, their son, 7, sustained minor injuries. Police said an FIR would be filed against the deceased SUV driver,

Vishal Ganpatlal Jain, 36, for allegedly driving the vehicle "at a very high speed". The accident took place when the family was heading back to Ahmedabad in their MG Hector SUV, said police. Their car hit the back of a truck, crushing the entire front portion of the car, killing Jain and Usha on the spot, said inspector H V Raval of 'A' Division Traffic police. Raval said both the children were taken

to a local hospital for treatment. The inspector further said that an FIR would be filed against Jain for driving the SUV at a very high speed that had led to the accident with the truck that was moving in the middle lane of the expressway. Raval further said officials of the SUV company have also been called in to probe if any technical problem in the car could have caused the accident. **ENS**
